

CHAPTER TWO

THE BEGINNING OF THE END

Biblical numerology is a curious subject among many people; so, I can share only what I know, but it will not tell us too much. Many people believe that if they knew about biblical numerology, it would reveal much more about the future; this is not so, or at least not as far as I am aware of because the future is already told in the Scriptures., and what has happened in the past is what happens again.

GENESIS 5:22 And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:

None of the Character in the Scriptures are about people. All the nouns as words of etymology. The Scriptures are not only made up of etymology, but also covert words and slang. Words change, but the roots usually remain intact. Etymology is from the roots of ancient Hebrew, Greek and Latin words. Now, let's take a look at what the Scripture in Genesis 5:22 is saying:

- ENOCH means, Inaugurated, Trained
- METHUSELAH means, When He Is Dead It Shall Be Sent, Man of A Javelin
- THREE HUNDRED YEARS speaks of an era about *the earth, the sea and food.*
- SON AND DAUGHTER are about all *the things we think about..* SONS are the *positive*, and DAUGHTERS are the *negative*.

To interpret what Gen. 5:22 is saying that when man comes to earth, he is dead and suffers all the negative things that God described on the next Scriptures.

GENESIS 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire *shall be* to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

17 And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat *of* it all the days of thy life;

18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field;

Whether you value your life or not, only you can change it. You are in charge of the future. I am hoping that each of us will think positive and live accordingly to the laws of man. God has given us each a chance to repent, by letting us return to earth and try again. Let's hope that there is hope for the hopeless.

We have seen or heard of how the earth has been overturned; and this is something that we don't like to think of. We have probably been born into the last generation and are seeing many of the changes that the Scriptures talk about.

LUKE 10:23 And he turned him unto his disciples, and said privately, Blessed are the eyes which see the things that ye see:

24 For I tell you, that many prophets and kings have desired to see those things which ye see, and have not seen them; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard them.

The Bible is a book of parables; the entire book is a parable and there are many parables within the parables. If I tell you that there are no people or places or anything tangible in the Scriptures; You would say that I need to have my head examined.

The Scriptures were written a long time ago, even before this earth was created, and ones before them.

LUKE 21:32 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled.

33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.

The story of Noah is a good place to start this Little Book because it is not only about the end and the beginning, but it will also have a lot of numerology in it.

Noah

Before Noah, we should know where he came from. In the story about Adam and Eve, we are told about the two brothers, Cain and Abel and what the world was like before God found favor in Noah.

- CAIN is a word that means a *spear and a political leader*.
- ABEL means vanity *or breath*.

As the story goes, Cain killed this brother Abel and went out from the presence of the LORD and dwelt in the land of Nod. In the beginning the earth was such a beautiful place, a place of pristine or abundant natural beauty. But, because of the sins of man, that beauty was demolished. The EAST refers to the *sins* of man.

GENESIS 4:16 And Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden.

There are two more characters that are born before the beginning of the Noah; these are the characteristics of Seth and Lamech

- SETH means *the anointed*.
- LAMECH means a strong man, for humiliation.
- NOAH is a word that means a rest or a time of peace.

After a period of time, just about everyone on Earth is so corrupt that God is sorry that He created them, and He decides to destroy them and start over again. We see proof every day how the earth is falling apart amid an increase in severe weather patterns.; this is a preview of what is coming, and no one is going to be exempt. However, God found favor in Noah we are some of Noah's family that need to be saved.

**GENESES 5:28 And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son:
29 And he called his name Noah, saying, This *same* shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed.**

The hundred eighty and two years, talked about the Scripture, above, means that this is a time of a corrupted world, and we need a rest and a time of peace. This is a number that was derived from adding eight and two together.

Before continuing on to teach you about Noah, here is a lesson on how to identify the numbers that are in the Scriptures.

There are two ways in which to identify the Scriptures. Listed below are twelve holy numbers that give us more information about the Scriptures; you will need to keep this list handy for a better understanding of the Scriptures. As we proceed in learning what the Scriptures mean, I will keep referring back to the chart that is shown below.

The Twelve Holy Numbers

1 = Light and the beginning
2 = Our range of universal thought
3 = Earthly thoughts
4 = Spiritual thoughts of understanding
5 = The living, a nation, or religion
6 = Biological man, which God created on the 6th day, the Gentiles
7 = God's number of completeness, belonging to God
8 = Unity or oneness
9 = The first number of the Holy Ghost, levels in heaven, the gifts of the Holy Ghost
10=Lucifer, the devil, and the fallen
11=The second coming of Christ and reborn within you.
12=God's people, Israel; God's division outside the Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

Associating Word Meanings

Words that add to the same number often have the same annotation. These words can be identified by associating each letter of a word to a corresponding number, and then adding the numbers together. Along with learning what the words in the Scriptures are telling us, numbers also have meanings, and sometimes can reveal a supportive truth to the Word of God. It can be supportive for you to learn this numerology, for it will help you to read between the lines of the Scriptures.

This chart, shown here, gives us the corresponding numbers:

There are twenty-six letters in the English alphabet; and if you link the number to God, will see that G = 7, O =15, and D = 4; by adding these three numbers together we arrive at twenty-six. There are obviously many words that total this same number; there is APACE, which means *quickly*; BARE, which means *revelation*, or BEAR, which means to *tolerate*. EAT and HEAL *freeing us from grief, troubles and evil*; all these have a total of twenty-six. FLAG is also listed among these words, and it is *a warning signal*. These are all things that have something in common with the Scriptures.

Sometimes, when finding words to help identify a Scripture in question, we can be thrown for a loop because Jesus and Lucifer both have the same numerical number. Each of the words in this list have the same number. Would you know which word would be referring to Jesus? Or Lucifer? *Beauty, Bitter, Blind, Bottle, Bozez, Bruise, Closet, Cross, Epitome, Fruit, Gospel, Hand of God, Heavens, Increase, The King, Loaves, Lucifer, Manifold, Messiah, Pharez, Pinnacle, Sloth, and Tempt*. This is only a partial list of the words ending in seventy-four.

If we don't know whether the Scripture is about Jesus or about Satan, or some other aspect, we can refer to adding the chapter and verse numbers together; this gives us a code offering more information about the Scriptures. Numbers that are spelled out within a Scripture reveal a hidden mystery. All numbers above the twelve holy numbers that are shown above, must be broken down until they equal one of the twelve holy numbers.

The word, RELIGION, is not mentioned in Canon of the Bible, but other words relating to it are found, and they are Billow, Crown, Egypt, Hunger, Kingdom, Stone, and Thistle. You will find Religion in the Book of Acts and the Epistles because

these are the words of man. Its number equals seventy-three, and if you add these two numbers together, they all add to ten.

The number seven always belongs to God, while the number ten always refers to the fallen and those belonging to Satan. These holy numbers only apply to the Canon and do *not* apply to the Book of Acts nor the Epistles. For an example: take a chapter number, in instance Chapter 5, and add to it to a Scripture number, like verse 32; [5+3+2=10] This method of deciphering Scripture *only* applies to Scriptures that are in the Canon of the Bible and *not* to the Book of Acts or the Epistles.

The churches are great for helping people be good, but there are still a lot of corrupt people who go to church also. Religion isn't going to save anyone. Even the good people have been denied the truth about God; and this is what the Scriptures are trying to tell us. The churches are good to a certain extent, but they added a lot of stuff to their doctrine that deflects from the nature of God; and this is blasphemy!

God said to Noah, to build an Ark, and He gave him the measurements on how to do this. This book was called the Ark, but we call it the Bible. The non-believers of God imagine the ark of Noah as being a boat, but to the trained eye we will see, that it is indeed, the Scriptures that are in the Bible. This same ark applies to the Ark of the Covenant, and to the Ark that hid the baby Moses among the flags. FLAGS are signals for directions.

There have been boats built throughout history, and carried livestock around the world, but none of these are the ark that is in the Scriptures. It is ironic how the minds of some people can run amuck and think that they have discovered something that man-built thousands of years ago.

GENESIS 6:13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

There are some things, however, that have survived a world that existed from the last earth when there was giant; these are giant structures such as the pyramids, the sphinx and the statues around Easter Island, just to name a few, and are not named in the Scriptures.

GENESIS 6:4 There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare *children* to them, the same *became* mighty men which *were* of old, men of renown.

I have heard many years ago, although I can't find it now, that incest causes children to be born in a smaller form. This is purely a far-fetched speculation, but I wonder if perhaps this is why man is much smaller in today's world.

DEUTERONOMY 2:19 And when thou comest nigh over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon any possession; because I have given it unto the children of Lot for a possession.

20 (That also was accounted a land of giants: giants dwelt therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims;

21 A people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims; but the LORD destroyed them before them; and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead.

- AMMON means *people or kinsman*.
- LOT means protected, hidden, enveloped.
- ZAMZUMMIM means Schemers, The Devised Against.
- ANAKIM means Long-Necked, Ornamented / Ornamentor.

The Ark

What is provided for you here in Little Book are the basics. There is an idiom that says, “God helps those who help themselves.” This Little Book is your toolbox; there is a list of meanings for some of the words in etymology at the end of the Little Book. You will also find a list of other words, called delineation,

There are many delineations in the story of Noah and the ark. Let’s see how God told Noah to make it: It is to be made with gopher wood and pitched. GOPHERS are *diggers*, which means that we are going to have to do a bit of digging before our eyes are opened. WOOD implies to the bible’s *hidden meanings*; and all the stories are to be *slanted* with PITCH.

GENESIS 6:14 Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

The dimensions of the Ark were given in numbers. These *numbers* are called CUBITS. God tells Noah to place a door at the lowest level and add two more levels above it. These levels afford advancement as we progress in our learning. Jesus is the doorway of the sheep. We are the SHEEP *because we stray* away from knowing our one true God who is our shepherd.

John 10:7 Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.

There is a window in the ark, which allows us to see through.

GENESIS 6:16 A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; with lower, second, and third stories shalt thou make it.

The Ark has three ‘stories’ which are the three levels of truth. Only the second and third stories are listed with a number, adding to a five. Five is a number that

indicates that everyone is to enjoy them. All truth passes through three stages: First, it is ridiculed; second, it is violently opposed; and third, it is accepted as self-evident.

God made a covenant with Noah; this is a promise that if we repent from our sins and *never sin again*, we will be saved! However, it is too easy to look upon our fellow man and criticize him for wrong doings. There are so many lies being told to the public that we don't even know who is telling the truth and who is not. It is generally the most attractive people who are the vilest. God never judges us by what we look like. We can be black, white, purple or green. Noah was told that there is to be two of everything, which is the positive and the negative.

GENESIS 6:18-19 But with thee will I establish my covenant; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee. And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every *sort* shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep *them* alive with thee; they shall be male and female.

A reminder that SONS are *thoughts and feelings and ideas* that are put into action. All the things that are mentioned in this next set of Scriptures are listed here for your understanding. The three [3] wives are about the earth, sea, and food. The things of the Earth.

- NOAH means peace and tranquility, and *a time of rest*.
- SHEM is the *wonderful councilor*.
- HAM means *hot, anger or burnt*.
- JAPHETH refers to all the *non-believers of the truth of God*.
- WIVES are the principles attached to the characters.
- BEAST points to mankind.
- CATTLE are all the people of no importance.
- FOWL and BIRDS are beliefs that fly away.
- FLESH refers to all the things that we believe in.

GENESIS 7:13 In the selfsame day entered Noah, and Shem, and Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife, and the three wives of his sons with them, into the ark;

14 They, and every beast after his kind, and all the cattle after their kind, and every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind, and every fowl after his kind, every bird of every sort.

15 And they went in unto Noah into the ark, two and two of all flesh, wherein *is* the breath of life.

Even if we don't get the whole meaning of the Scriptures, we can at least get an idea of what they are about by knowing what the words are directing us to. The world is the tree of knowledge of good and evil. CLEAN means those *who have repented*, and SEVEN is a number that *belongs to the God*. The SEED is the *message of truth*.

GENESIS 7: AND the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation.

2 Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that *are* not clean by two, the male and his female.

3 Of fowls also of the air by sevens, the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.

It is not important to know anything about numerology, but it might settle a question that is in our minds. The important thing is to know what the Scriptures are about and to share them, especially with those who are unable to see them for themselves. Everyone who reads this Little Book is to be a witness and a servant for the LORD; He can't do it without you.

ISAIAH 43:8 Bring forth the blind people that have eyes, and the deaf that have ears.

9 Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, *It is truth*.

10 Ye *are* my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I *am* he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.

11 I, *even I, am* the LORD; and beside me *there is* no saviour.

We must appreciate the things we have, no matter how small. We must know that we are a part of God, and He has spared us from some of the worse things that have happened for a reason, and we must know how to enjoy life without sinning.

ISAIAH 43:12 I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when *there was* no strange *god* among you: therefore ye *are* my witnesses, saith the LORD, that I *am* God.

13 Yea, before the day *was* I *am* he; and *there is* none that can deliver out of my hand: I will work, and who shall let it?

The mention of forty days is seen quite often in the Scriptures. The forty, which is $[4+0=4]$ points to sun, the moon and the stars, and understanding the Scriptures.

The raven is that principle that turns our heads until the word of God no longer exists. The dove is the aspect of enjoying life to the end.

GENESIS 8:13 And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first *month*, the first *day* of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

Let's look at the numbers here; Six hundred and first year, $[6+1=7]$, plus the first month and the first day. $[7+1+1=9]$ This Scripture is talking about starting life all over again in the new world. The nine is the first level of heaven, this is what the earth is like when we first arrive. We are God! The chapter above, and verse number,

combined are $[8+1+3=12]$ which means God's people, Israel and also the trinity of you, me and the Holy Spirit.

AMOS 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:

12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it.

13 In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst.
