



CHAPTER 4

THE POWER OF PRAYER

Prayers are a special time spent with you and your maker. It doesn't matter if you are standing up, sitting down, lying in bed or using the toilet as long as you are alone with God and nobody can see or hear you. Prayers can be said out loud or silently; as long as you are earnest and believe. AMEN means that you *earnestly believe* that they will be answered...this is where the power is.

Frivolous prayers are made in public. A lot of people believe that their maker is a God who is looking down on us from above. Prayer is a time for asking God for the things that will help us spiritually to be better.

There appears to be little thought that the kingdom of heaven is at hand or even within us.

MATTHEW 6: 31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Praying for a certain sports team to win a game is idiocy, for the opposite teams have the same desires. Winning comes in practice and improvement.

Satan also answers prayers. SATAN is *the adversary, the one that resists* the things that are the promises of the God. Satan's power is strong, he hears open prayers made in public and he can resist the ones he wants to resist. Peter is an adversary, even though he is a disciple of Jesus. The meaning of PETER is a *Rock, or a stone*.

MATTHEW 16:23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get

thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

The Parting of the Red Sea

When the children of Israel are in Egypt, the world is without any goodness; we are slaves to a government, and we worship all manmade items.

The things that are in *our mind* is called the SEA. When man has become angry enough with the ways of the world, the sea turns red. God delivers the children of Israel out of Egypt by parting the Red Sea so they could escape. This phenomenon, which has perplexed man, is a parable. Moses is of the words of God that opens our eyes to the other side of the Scriptures and what they mean.

PSALM 76: GIVE ear, O my people, to my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.

2 I will open my mouth in a parable: I will utter dark sayings of old:

3 Which we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us.

Before the Bible was available to the public and shoved down our throats, our fathers were told about the necessary things that we need to know for our survival. Many of these things are still buried within us.

MATTHEW 13:10 And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables?

11 He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.

12 For whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath.

13 Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand.

Everything we have ever seen or known in life is stored in our minds; this stays with us forever. The brain is a peculiar thing. It's a mystery in itself. It is surprising at what all is in our heads also.

When people look up into the sky seeking the kingdom of heaven, they are looking away from God instead of toward Him.

LUKE 17:21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

The Fishes of the Sea

Even though the brain being made up of 75% water, there are a lot of questions about God and Jesus swimming around in our heads; the WATER that the Scriptures are about *are the Words of God*. There are a lot of questions swimming around in our minds; *these questions* are referred to as the FISHES OF THE SEA. Every time we get *an answer*, it's like catching a FISH.

There is a parable about this. It is a story about the man who is racking his brains for answers. Most followers may see Jesus sees as they are mending their nets, but they have neither caught no fish nor have recognized him.

Jesus tells them that if they follow him, he will make them fishers of men, for they will be able to answer many questions for those who seek the truth.

MATTHEW 4:18 And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

19 And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

20 And they straightway left *their* nets, and followed him.

21 And going on from thence, he saw other two brethren, James *the son* of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he called them.

The fish is a symbol used by the church for Jesus Christ. However the fish that is associated with religion stinks.

EXODUS 7:17 Thus saith the LORD, In this thou shalt know that I *am* the LORD: behold, I will smite with the rod that *is* in mine hand upon the waters which *are* in the river, and they shall be turned to blood.

18 And the fish that is in the river shall die, and the river shall stink; and the Egyptians shall loathe to drink of the water of the river.

The word ROD means the Word of God. In the 23rd Psalm, the inclusion ‘thy rod and thy staff shall comfort thee’, means the *Word of God and his servants shall teach you*.

Groping in the Dark

Man is infatuated with life of this Earth, which is a case of blind love. We see, and yet we don’t see.

LUKE 8:17 For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither *any thing* hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.

18 Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.

When a person is so adamant about something that is in opposition of what the Scriptures are telling us, he may be a dog; this does not mean that he is a bad person because DOGS are *low contemptible people*. You can find the meaning of dogs, and many other words, by searching the Merriam Webster Dictionary. Pearls are beacons of light for those who see the world through spiritual lenses. The Scriptures have another word for low *contemptible people*; it is SWINE!

MATTHEW 7:6 Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.

The dogs, which is gods spelled backwards, have taken the Scriptures and brainwashed us with muddy water from a river. This FISH that are in the river are *the answers to our questions* may stink.

EXODUS 7:18 And the fish that is in the river shall die, and the river shall stink; and the Egyptians shall lothe to drink of the water of the river.

The things that are being taught in this Little Book are like pearls. They are very precious and should not be shared with those who are going to trample them. We can

make mention of them, and if the other party is interested in what you are implying, then you can share your discoveries.

MATTHEW 7:6 Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.

7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

9 Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?

10 Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

Many of our questions are answered in our sleep, and sometimes during meditation. However, many of the things that are revealed in our sleep are forgotten upon awakening up to this world. A *STONE* is *half lies* told in a way that the truth of it is lost.

The Pope

If there is to be a reformation among Christians, it must come from Pope Francis. His election was unexpected for many, as he was not considered a front runner when it came to electing a new Pope. However, his humility and concern for the poor; and his commitment for social justice, deeply impressed the cardinals during their assembly. Pope Francis' journey from a humble background to the highest office in the Catholic Church underscores his extreme impact on the world. However, a lot of the policies the Pope Frances wanted changed, has faced a lot of criticism from devout conservative Catholics against the policies of the church that he wants to reform; a some of it is the stance on religion.

Perhaps the low, contemptible priest wanted a puppet that they could easily control. Child molestation and other atrocious acts have been defended among many of the churches notorious colleagues.

MATTEW 17:29 And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put *it* upon his head, and a reed in his right hand:

**and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying,
Hail, King of the Jews!**

Even though Pope Francis has been unable to accomplish a lot of the things he set out to do, the children of Isarel can attempt to carry out this mission. Even though the Bible is not for everyone, we should all be taught the things that are *in* the bible, like how to pray. As a child of Israel, we must remember the kingdom of God is *within* us. I shall repeat that there is power in prayer, as long as we have the faith to believe in the things that we pray for will happen. Relics like Prayer Beads and statues don't answer prayers; faith does.

MATTHEW 6:7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knows what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

Mary, the mother of Jesus

The Egyptian etymology for the meaning for all names that begin with MAR is 'love'; but the Hebrew definitions means *man's rebellion*, or to *be bitter and strong*; this is the aspiration that brought forth Jesus. Mary is the mother of Jesus. This is the rebellion against a society that is hampering the people. It is not fought with violence, but with the love of Jesus. We can admit our sin but tell our enemies that the have the same sins as we have had, but we are not going to hide them anymore. Joseph is the father of Jesus. JOSEPH is also an attribute that means *increase*, or *may he add*.

Since Jesus was born out of rebellion for society, we must change our ways and encourage others to do the same. JESUS is a word that means *salvation*.

LUKE 2: 8 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

12 And this *shall be* a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

This list of words will appear in the same order in which they appear in the Scriptures.

- SAME COUNTRY: This pertains to those who also searching for truth.
- SHEPHERDS: Those who are sowing the seed, or the Word.
- FIELD: This means the area of interest that we are following in.
- FLOCKS: This is us.
- NIGHT: Not knowing all the truth.
- ANGEL: He who come to the rescue.
- SHONE: A spark of interest.
- DAY: Awareness of the truth.
- CITY: Status
- DAVID: Love
- SAVIOR: Jesus, or the Word
- BABE: A plan
- SWADDLIN CLOTHES: How covert words cover the real meanings.
- MANGER: The heart

LUKE 1:18 And all they that heard *it* wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds.

19 But Mary kept all these things, and pondered *them* in her heart.

The Commandments

If you are of God, *then know that you are God*. We have each created our own image. Please take a look at these next four Scriptures. We can only exemplify God with respect for self and for others.

JOHN 4:24 God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.

GENESIS 1:27 So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

God is the Spirit that has made you what you are; He is the Spirit that is inside you. We are not to worship a spirit that is way off somewhere, but the one that is side you.

ISAIAH 45:7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.

This is a spirit that created both good and bad. The good is the light that lets us know who we really are.

JOHN 14:10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

God's spirit lives within you. We must know the truth: know that the kingdom of heaven is within us and that Jesus is the name of the laws that we must follow.

We are not to have any other gods before us. These gods are in the form of material things that break and don't last. They may be a temporary enjoyment for a while but can also be costly. If we are in a position to make money, it needs to be shared by putting others to work and helping them to survive.

Our father is our spirit, and our mother is the earth on which we live. We must honor them both with respect, both body and soul.

We should not take the life of another person or an animal unless it is in self-defense. Animals have feelings and can exemplify love too.

Thou shalt not commit adultery. The marriage vow is one that should be between you and God. If you commit yourself to doing His will, He will keep His promise; A wedding vow is a commitment between you and God; it is called a covenant. Marriages that are made on earth between two individuals; should never be for life. Not all these marriages last and can turn nasty.

**JEREMIAH 3:14 Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD; for I am married unto you: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to Zion:
15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.**

Thou shalt not steal. If we borrow something it must be returned and in the same condition you took it.

Bearing false witness is crime, which is intended to hurt the innocent, but when both sides accuse the other of wrong-doing, the innocent party doesn't know which side to believe. We will know them by their fruits and deeds.

**MATTHEW 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
16 Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?**

When the Scriptures talk about a house, it is about a classification, such as being of the house of God. The people of the Earth are our neighbors, and we are their guests. There is no way that we can return to heaven, as long as we desire the things of the Earth.

Most people don't know that there is a difference between pride and pleased. Pride is a sin.

PROVERB 8:13 The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.

ISAIAH 2:12 For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low:

The Fate of the Children of Israel

WE are all sinners, and those who have come down from heaven are the children of Israel because our heads have been turned to the ways of the Earth. God has made a covenant with us; if we repent from the ways of the scribes and Pharisees and obey God's rules for us He will give us an eternal life in heaven.

These rules are explained in more detail in these Scriptures. God renamed Jacob to that of ISRAEL which means to *turn the head*. If we don't repent the things that follow will be our reward.

This set of Scriptures is an account of Jacob explaining to each of his sons what our destinies are. This is a long story that could be told in just a few short words: It tells

us that our heads are full of visions about the future. Verses 3-5 tell us that are listening or hearing what we want.

GENESIS 49 - AND Jacob called unto his sons and said Gather yourselves together that I may tell you *that* which shall befall you in the last days.

2 Gather yourselves together and hear ye sons of Jacob; and hearken unto Israel your father.

3 Reuben thou *art* my firstborn my might and the beginning of my strength the excellency of dignity and the excellency of power:

4 Unstable as water thou shalt not excel; because thou wentest up to thy father's bed; then defiledst thou *it*: he went up to my couch.

LEAH which means either *a mistress or a ruler* is the mother of six sons; the first son is that of REUBEN which means the *son of vision*. A BED that Reuben defiles is the *supporting surface* and a place of comfort. A COUCH is *an expression of words* and phrases.

SIMEON means to *listen or hear*, and LEVI means *attached*. These two principles are in likeness *to the* principles that apply to Simon. In this next text. Peter had denied knowing Jesus three times before the cock crowed. Whatever or however you live your life on earth, this will be the same way you will live it after you die. (*verse 29*)

MATTHEW 16:18 And I say also unto thee That thou art Peter and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

This next Scripture is about Leah giving birth to the first three principles, hoping for Jacob to love her.

GENESIS 49:5 Simeon and Levi *are* brethren; instruments of cruelty *are in* their habitations.

6 O my soul come not thou into their secret; unto their assembly mine honour be not thou united: for in their anger they slew a man and in their self will they digged down a wall.

7 Cursed *be* their anger for *it was* fierce; and their wrath for it was cruel: I will divide them in Jacob and scatter them in Israel.

Leah decided to give birth to a fourth son and see if this would make Jacob love her. JUDAH is the aspect of *thanksgiver and full of praise*. It is from this tribe that king David and the Jews arise and Jesus is born. Jacob tells us of the strength that can arise from thanksgiving and praise.

GENESIS 49:8 Judah thou *art he* whom thy brethren shall praise: thy hand *shall be* in the neck of thine enemies; thy father's children -shall bow down before thee.

9 Judah *is* a lion's whelp: from the prey my son thou art gone up: he stooped down he couched as a lion and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?

10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah nor a lawgiver from between his feet until Shiloh come; and unto him *shall* the gathering of the people *be*.

SHILOH means '*He whose it is*'. As you have just read in the set of Scriptures above these, Mary is the rebellion that comes from those giving thanksgiving and praise. This is a rebellion that comes from Judah and from the tribe who gives birth to Jesus.

The Epistles and the Book of Acts are for the Gentiles. The Epistles are the words of Paul, and he was not a disciple of Jesus. This is what Paul writes:

1 CORINTHIANS 3:2 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able *to bear it*, neither yet now are ye able.

In Etymology, the meaning for PAUL is *Small, Cessation stopper, or a Whisper*. Binding a foal to vine is the same as attaching yourself to a religious belief, and God calls His children an ass if they do so.

GENESIS 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

12 His eyes *shall be* red with wine and his teeth white with milk.

ZEBULUN means a *dwelling of honor and self-satisfaction*. The people are pleased with religions, it gives them purpose, even though it is not the same purpose that shall not take us across the border. ZIDON means *hunting, fishing, or venison*.

GENESIS 49:13 Zebulun shall dwell at the haven of the sea; and he *shall be* for an haven of ships; and his border *shall be* unto Zidon.

ISSACHAR is a *man of hire wages, and has recompenses*. This is our pastors, the clergy who man pays to teach them about God. Some of these clergy have falsely used the name of Jesus to become millionaires.

GENESIS 49:14 Issachar is a strong ass couching down between two burdens:

15 And he saw that rest *was* good and the land that *it was* pleasant; and bowed his shoulder to bear and became a servant unto tribute.

RACHEL means *purity* and represents those thoughts that are non-religious, She wanted sons also, but is unable to have them and Jacob's anger was kindled against her; so she gives him Bilhah her handmade. BILHAH means *trouble and calamity*. Dan is her first son. DAN means that *the LORD is my judge*. I attribute all revised bible to that of Dan; for he is an *adder* that had added other stuff to the Scriptures and had caused the children of Israel to fall backward in our reaching the kingdom of heaven.

GENESIS 49:16 Dan shall judge his people as one of the tribes of Israel.

17 Dan shall be a serpent by the way an adder in the path that biteth the horse heels so that his rider shall fall backward.

18 I have waited for thy salvation O LORD.

When Leah saw that she had left bearing, she took Zilpah her maid and gave her Jacob to wife. ZILPAH means a *drop*. and she produced Gad. And Leah said A troop cometh: GAD brings us *fortune*.

GENESIS 49 19 Gad a troop shall overcome him: but he shall overcome at the last.

Understanding the Scriptures gives us pleasure, it makes us happy. ASHER means to makes *happy*. This is why this Little Book is bread; eat it up!

GENESIS 49:20 Out of Asher his bread shall be fat and he shall yield royal dainties.

It is inevitable that this information will fall into some wrong hands; it cannot be avoided. And Bilhah, Rachel's maid, conceived again and bare Jacob a second son and called his name NAPHTALI. which means *wrestling or crafty*.

GENESIS 49:21 Naphtali is a hind let loose: he giveth goodly words.

Then Jacob goes into a long spill about the fate of JOSHEPH is *the increaser*, this can also mean *maybe*, or to *repeat*. Joseph's mother is RACHEL; this means *purity*. Because of its length we will skip this part for Jacob tell about how this is an aspect of many viewpoints.

GENESIS 49:22 Joseph is a fruitful bough even a fruitful bough by a well; whose branches run over the wall:

All things that are blessed among the forefathers which are the sons that proceeded Jospeh; he shall be prevailed above them when they learn to look up to him with repentance. The crown is on his head. the first son on RACHEL which means *purity*. The second son is called Benjamin.

GENESIS 49:27 Benjamin shall ravin as a wolf: in the morning he shall devour the prey and at night he shall divide the spoil.

BENJAMIN is *the son of the south* and he is the son who is on the *the right side of God*.

GENESIS 49:28 All these are the twelve tribes of Israel: and this is it that their father spake unto them and blessed them; every one according to his blessing he blessed them.

You will be seeing these names as we progress through the Scriptures. Here is a recap on what you just read:

Jacob's wives

Let's do a total recap on who we are. We are the children of God, and when we first came into this world we were of a clean and clear mind. As soon as we came into this world Israel was there waiting for us so that he could turn out heads toward the ways of physical life. We have all enjoyed our antics here and have sinned; and in doing this, we all became his adopted children.

JACOB is the aspect of being God's children after we came down from heaven. This is the aspect that turned us away from the type of life we had before we began mingling with the people of the Earth. ISRAEL is an expression of *looking the other way*.

When the children of God began seeing themselves as children of the Earth, they became a child of Israel and became sinners. We must try to escape this hold and become they type of person that God intends for us to be. Jacob is the father of twelve sons. These represent the attributes of life.

GENESIS 35:21 And Israel journeyed, and spread his tent beyond the tower of Edar.

EDAR is a word that means *flock*; and the children of God are like a flock of sheep, and we represent JACOB because he is *follower and is behind*. As Israel journeyed and spread his *beliefs and his way of life* among the flocks; thus is the meaning of a TENT.

In doing a double take, REUBEN is the *son of vision which* slept with BILHAH, meaning *trouble and calamity*. Bilhah is a concubine of just one of Israels many thoughts sinister thoughts.

GENESIS 35:22 And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: and Israel heard it. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve:

Twelve does not apply to the number, because it represents God's people who have left heaven to follow the ways of the Earth.

GENESIS 35:23 The sons of Leah; Reuben, Jacob's firstborn, and Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Zebulun:

LEAH is *a mistress or a ruler* in which Jacob is attached to. Along with Reuban, came SIMEON AND LEVI, which means that they *listened and heard* about the trouble and calamity that is caused by this vision. ZEBULUN comes along later; this is *a dwelling of honor and self-satisfaction*.

GENESIS 35:24 The sons of Rachel; Joseph, and Benjamin:

Rachel's sons are much better, but she is not married to Jacob. Her viewpoints are for JOSEPH to *increase respect* and maybe adding to BENJAMIN which is the *son of the right side of God*

GENESIS 35:25 And the sons of Bilhah, Rachel's handmaid; Dan, and Naphtali:

Trouble and calamity, which is Bilhah and a handmaid to purity produces both ISSACHAR is the man of hire with wages and has recompenses; and DAN, which means that the LORD is my judge.

GENESIS 35:26 And the sons of Zilpah, Leah's handmaid; Gad, and Asher: these are the sons of Jacob, which were born to him in Padan-aram.

PADAM-ARAM points to a viewpoint PADAM makes the things *slanted*, while ARAM means *high* or something that has been rammed into our heads. ZILPAH is *a drop* in what is to bring us *fortune* and make *happy*; these are the qualities of GAD and Asher.

I shall ram you with a little more detail so that you will remember what the children of Israel is all about.

- LEAH is our government, which produce a vision and a dwelling of honor and self-satisfaction to those who listen and hear.
- RACHEL is the Purity that we will achieve if we repent from being cattish and turn to the right side of God.
- ZILPAH represents a decline.
- BILHAH points to our paid judges and those who gow what they thi by the bible.

EXODUS 1 - NOW these *are* the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt; every man and his household came with Jacob.

2 Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah,

3 Issachar, Zebulun, and Benjamin,

4 Dan, and Naphtali, Gad, and Asher.

And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt *already*.

6 And Joseph died, and all his brethren, and all that generation.

These are the aspects and manifestations of those whose heads have been turned to the ways of the world. ISREAL means *to turn the head* back toward our own creator and the real God.

We are the children of Israel and have reached the point of Joseph.s Benjamin is on the verge of existence.

- REUBEN is the *son of vision*.
- SIMEON means to *listen or hear*.
- LEVI means *attached* .
- JUDAH is the aspect of thanksgiver and full of praise.
- ZEBULUN is a dwelling of honor and self-satisfaction.
- ISSACHAR is a man of hire, wages, has recompenses.
- DAN means that the LORD is my judge.
- GAD brings us *fortune*.
- ASHER makes us *happy*.
- NAPHTALI means wrestling or crafty.
- JOSEPH is is *the increaser*, this can also mean *maybe*, or to *repeat*
- BENJAMIN is the son of the south, or the *son of the right side of God*

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Sacrificing Isaac

There is a story of Abraham taking his beloved son to a place where he thinks that God wanted him to sacrifice Isaac for a burnt offering to the churches. ISAAC is a

17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:

18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

Love, forgiveness and obeying the rest of God laws is what takes us to the housetop; these are characteristic that may not prolong our life in this world, but they will make us much happier in the next one.

Man has a tendency to treat people who are different from themselves with dissatisfaction; this can point to a reader of this Little Book because it differs from the what the majority believes. It is for this reason that if you believe the things told you here are true, do not expose them because everyone else will think that you have lost your mind.

Let us take a look at the Book of Daniel: There are a lot of words in this one short Scripture. Do you know what any of them mean? These words will all be defined for you.

DANIEL 1 - IN the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.

- The THIRD year points to The Things Of The Earth.
- JEHOIAKIM means to Rise Up and Stand
- JUDAH is a quality of Praise and Thanksgiving.
- NEBUCHADNEZZAR means to Serve the Crown
- BABYLON is the amount of Confused Medley Of Sounds
- JERUSALEM means to Point the Way To Completeness.

DANIEL 1:3 And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring *certain* of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes;

4 Children in whom *was* no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as *had* ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans.

It is unclear what the etymology is for Chaldeans; but some believe that it is the same *As if It Were A Mountain/ Field / Protecting Spirit / Breast*. Daniel, which is to bring

certain of the children of Israel the aspects of knowledge and wisdom of the kingdom of heaven which has been turned to learning the ways of the earth.

In this next Scripture, we find a bunch of other words that seem to have no meaning. You will find their definitions following the Scripture.

DANIEL 1:7 Unto whom the prince of the eunuchs gave names: for he gave unto Daniel *the name* of Belteshazzar; and to Hananiah, of Shadrach; and to Mishael, of Meshach; and to Azariah, of Abed-nego.

- DANIEL is a word that means *The LORD is My Judge*.
- BELSHAZZAR means Baal, *Lady*, or *Protect The King*.
- EUNUCHS are the guards of the Harem.
- HANANIAH means Yah Has Been Gracious.
- SHADRACH means tender nipple or nonsense.
- MICHAEL means Who Is Like God?.
- MESHACH is a Guest of A King" or "Who Is What God Is.
- AZARIAH Yah Has Helped
- ABED-NEGO A Work of Light, Servant of Nego (To know but pretend the opposite)

In reading some of the bible stories told to children, there seems to be an emphasis put on the event to the four men walking through the fire. FIRE is a word that means *Exposing the truth*.

DANIEL 3:25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

Each of us is of God, He has created us in His likeness. Even though we were created in the likeness of God, the woman has had an impact on our lives and our heads have been turned. This means that we have created our own selves to be what we want to be, but we can always change back. In order to survive, Daniel and his friends had to go with the flow while mentally keeping their faith in their true self,

We must know who we are and exemplify God the way in which He intended; and we must also sow the seed of His Words so that others can be saved because there will be some of His people who will be destroyed along with all the tare.

JOHN 10:30 I and my Father are one.

The twelve principles of Jesus are his disciples. Jesus is not a man, but a *Word* that is meant to save. The names are derived from the roots of words, James, which is the brother of Jesus has the same root as Jacob, *Ja* which means to follow behind.

MARK 6:7 And he called *unto him* the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;

8 And commanded them that they should take nothing for *their* journey, save a staff only; no scribe, no bread, no money in *their* purse:

There are numbers in the preceding Scripture: two and two add up to the holy number of four, which means understanding the Scriptures. We are not to have in our possession a bible, or give any type of a sermon, or belong to a society that has money.

MATTHEW 19:21 Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go *and* sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come *and* follow me.

Disciples of Jesus:

1. SIMON means to *listen* or hear; PETER means *heard*.
2. ANDREW means to *be strong*.
3. JAMES is the heel grabber or one who *follows behind*, but is the son of ZEBEDEE, which is *a gift of God*, and a brother to JOHN which means *mercy*.
4. PHILLIP is very *quick* in what he does.
5. BARTHOLOMEW overflows with religion.
6. THOMAS reverts to *revised bibles*.
7. MATTHEW is *God's gift*.
8. JAMES is the heel grabber or *follows behind*, but he is the son of ALPHAESUS, which makes him *the successor*.
9. LEBBAEUS means *praised*.
10. THADDAEUS who *preaches*.
11. SIMON THE CANAANITE is a political listener who hears.
12. JUDAS ISCARIOT means praise for a traitor.

Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver. The thirty which is 3+0 equals an earthly possession of money. This is what led to the demise of the true meaning of what Jesus means.

MATTHEW 26:14 Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests,
15 And said *unto them*, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.
16 And from that time he sought opportunity to betray him.

You many be anxious to share your newly discovered news these discoveries, but don't bring up the subject of God to the enemy. It is good for you to let people know what you are reading; and if they ask questions, tell them about it and tell them also how they can find this Little Book on their own.

MARK 6:9 But *be* shod with sandals; and not put on two coats.
10 And he said unto them, In what place soever ye enter into an house, there abide till ye depart from that place.
11 And whosoever shall not receive you nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.

Solomon tells the people who are in Judaea to flee into the mountains. These means to turn to your churches and places of governments that can help you. These are the people who are educated in the ways and beliefs of the world. The mountains pertain to support from their governments and churches. But for them who have been educated in what the Scriptures mean, don't do anything to change your thoughts.
