

CHAPTER TWO

LEARNING THE THREE R's

Reveal, Redeem and Rescue

Most folks may be too young to remember the song called: 'School Days'. Witten in 1907; but its popularity has been around for a long time and is still sung about Readin' And 'Ritin' And 'Rithmetic 150 years later Time have changed to whereas the people on the left hand of God see it better for them but spiritually it is much worse.

Reading the Bible and understanding it are two different things. The Gentiles and all the people of religion can read this book and believe what they see; but to the children of Israel who are the disciples of Jesus Christ we are to see the other side of these Scriptures and this is why Jesus always spoke to the multitude in parables.

MATTHEW 13:10 And the disciples came and said unto him Why speakest thou unto them in parables?

11 He answered and said unto them Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven but to them it is not given.

12 For whosoever hath to him shall be given and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not from him shall be taken away even that he hath.

13 Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not neither do they understand.

This is because the Scriptures were written for the children of Israel; these are the spiritual beings who came down from heaven and became sinners while mixing in with the people of the earth. ISRAEL means *turn the head*.

The Scriptures are about bringing the children of Israel out of Egypt. There are a lot of countries mentioned in the Scriptures but none of them are in reference to the Countries of the world in which we live in.

All nouns are of an etymological root. The children of Israel must either have their heads turned back toward our LORD else be destroyed along with all the corrupted people of the earth.

The Meanings of Countries

- ASIA represents a condition where the mind is muddy or boggy.
- ASSYRIA refers to crossings or regions beyond God's world.
- CALVARY is the place of the skull that houses knowledge is stored.
- EDEN represents the place of pleasure and delight.
- EDOM means seethe in anger seeing red.
- BETHLEHAM means the house of bread and spiritual food.
- EGYPT is the goat lustful; organized religion worship of idols.
- ETHIOPIA is of a fiery eye keen of vision.
- JERSUSALEM means to point the way to completeness.
- ISRAEL means to turn the head.
- SAMARIA is a place of watch keeping and goodwill.
- SIDON is a of place for fishing for the truth.
- PERSIA means the division and sciences taking place in the world.
- SINAI is the thorn bush lay to waste and our out woes.

Learning the basics of this Little Book will be like learning a whole new language. The words are the same but they all mean something different. Sometimes when you don't want the other person or people to know what you are talking about they might speak some form of pig Latin that have some other kind of code. Thus, it is with the Scriptures in the Bible. These Scriptures which is called *The Ark of the Covenant* were hand delivered to the priest so that they could teach the children of Israel.

JEREMIAH 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

16 And it shall come to pass when ye be multiplied and increased in the land in those days saith the LORD they shall say no more The ark of the covenant of the LORD: neither

shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it; neither shall that be done any more.

The Scriptures are all written in code; all the nouns are words from ancient Hebrew Greek and Latin words that are the names from which people and places are named for today. Plants and animals are named for the different traits of people. The law of the LORD of God is written in plain English for everyone to understand; there is no covert words in it.

Most of the children of Israel are still living in Egypt. We are all children no matter how old we are. Some people still think of a child as be a youngster or a toddling. However even young children are being taught the ways of the goat and many values have flown out the window.

The Well

Let's begin our story with Abram. ABRAM means many or multitude. Abram's wife is Sarai. SARAI means princess or Senate, which is the government.

**GENESIS16 - NOW Sarai Abram's wife bare him no children: and she had an handmaid, an Egyptian, whose name *was* Hagar.
3 And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife.**

The government's handmaid is an Egyptian called Hagar. EGYPTIAN pertains to *people of religion* who are at the service of the government. HAGAR means flight, to be dragged off, or pressed into service. Hagar was the perfect solution for the government which was unable to accomplish its goals; it needed to incorporate her service after Abram had developed enough wrongdoings. (Ten years)

GENESIS 16:2 And Sarai said unto Abram, Behold now, the LORD hath restrained me from bearing: I pray thee, go in unto my maid; it

may be that I may obtain children by her. And Abram hearkened to the voice of Sarai.

After the multitudes went into a matter of a mild religion, the government began to see that they despised it, for the people wanted nothing to do with the government.

This brings us to a condition of how the people feel about the government. The things that have happened before happens again.

What happens when the churches turn away from the government?

GENESIS 16:4 And he went in unto Hagar, and she conceived: and when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress was despised in her eyes.

5 And Sarai said unto Abram, My wrong *be* upon thee: I have given my maid into thy bosom; and when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her eyes: the LORD judge between me and thee.

6 But Abram said unto Sarai, Behold, thy maid *is* in thy hand; do to her as it pleaseth thee. And when Sarai dealt hardly with her, she fled from her face.

The Fountain

In this same story, there are more words that need to be defined. A FOUNTAIN OF WATER refers to the *origin of biblical words*. The *church* is referred to as the WILDERNESS; and Shur means a *wall or the bull*. The LORD tells those who have been dragged off into service to return to their government and follow her instructions. The SEED is the sowing of the *true word of God*.

GENESIS 16:7 And the angel of the LORD found her by a fountain of water in the wilderness, by the fountain in the way to Shur.

8 And he said, Hagar, Sarai's maid, whence camest thou? and whither wilt thou go? And she said, I flee from the face of my mistress Sarai.

9 And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Return to thy mistress, and submit thyself under her hands.

10 And the angel of the LORD said unto her, I will multiply thy seed exceedingly, that it shall not be numbered for multitude.

ISHMAEL is a word that means God hears. Hagar is the multitude of people who had been dragged off into service. The child is of the feelings and thoughts of the SON. This is a leader who is like a wild man and will have many followers and enemies.

GENESIS 16:11 And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou *art* with child, and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the LORD hath heard thy affliction.

12 And he will be a wild man; his hand *will be* against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren.

13 And she called the name of the LORD that spake unto her, Thou God seest me: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me?

Ishmael is the constitution. He is the first-born son of Abram and the makeup and foundation of an establishment. BEERLAHAI-ROI means *The Well of The Living One Who Sees, The Writing For A Life Of Vision.*

This well is between KADESH, which means *Holy, Sacred*; and BERED which means the etymology of the *Hebrew prefixes of words.*

GENESIS 16:14 Wherefore the well was called Beerlahai-roi; behold, *it is* between Kadesh and Bered.

- ABRAM means many or multitude
- SARAI means princess or Senate
- HAGAR means flight, to be dragged off, or pressed into service.
- ISHMAEL is a word that means *God hears*
- EGYPTIAN pertains to people *of religion*

The Samaritans

The road to the kingdom of heaven is open to the Gentiles, as well as for the children of Israel. There is a wonderful word that appears in the New Testament that is called Jesus. JESUS means *the salvation of Jehovah*; and JEHOVAH is a word that means *I AM*. All the things

that Jesus taught are found in the well of Ishmael which are holy, sacred, and found in the etymology of the Hebrew language. This is also the well of Jacob, but JACOB means to *follow* or *be behind*.

The PHARISEES is the *government*, and when the government hears that JESUS, which is *the Word of God* is reaching more people than what the churches teach, he no longer gives *thanks and praise* to other gods, he leaves JUDAEA, and life starts all over again. GALILEE means *circle*, or what will be again

**JOHN 4: - WHEN therefore the Lord knew how the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John,
2 (Though Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples,)
3 He left Judæa, and departed again into Galilee.**

The responsibility of the churches is to watch over their congregation and keep everyone happy and content. When Jesus comes to a CITY OF SAMARIA, which means that he has come upon the *status of the church*, he finds a PARCEL OF GROUND which is *the basis* for learning about the Word of God. But, JACOB, which means *being behind*, was slow in giving much *thought*, which is his SON, Joseph. The city of Samaria is called SYCHAR, and this means *liar, or drunkard*. JOSEPH means *Jehovah has added*.

ISAIAH 45:7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.

To continue with this story, it is a recap of things that were, and things that are happening now. Jacob's well is where the knowledge of the Scriptures are held. The events of this story says that this is THE SIXTH HOUR; it is the era of *non-believers in God*, and when Jesus has been sitting on the well.

**JOHN 4:4 And he must needs go through Samaria.
5 Then cometh he to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.**

6 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with his journey, sat thus on the well: and it was about the sixth hour.

The government is *a mountain*, the churches are our *watch tower*, and this is biblically called SAMARIA. The WOMAN, in this next verse, refers to *a source of life* and for those who are in want of water. WATER is *the Word of God*. When Jesus asks the woman what she knows about the truth, she replies that she doesn't know it because it is too deep for her the grasp. The JEWS are those who *give praise, the hand holders, or former*. The disciples of Jesus are those whose status is to buy meat. The MEAT is the *substance of the Scriptures*.

**JOHN 4:7 There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink.
8 (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.)
9 Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.**

It took me ninety years before the thought of etymology entered my mind. The woman says that Jacob is her father. Jacob is behind in knowing the truth; this is the doctrine of the churches. The GIFT OF GOD is the kingdom of heaven, though most people have not learned how to reach it. There is still too much sickness and misery going on in life. We are all CATTLE, which is that of being ordinary, unimportant people. We need to ask the LORD for the truth when we pray. This is why I share this revelation with you during my platinum years.

JOHN 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.

11 The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?

12 Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?

13 Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

- JACOB means to *follow or be behind*.
- JUDAEA means *thanksgiving and praise*
- GALILEE means *circle*, or what will be again
- JOSEPH means *Jehovah has added*.
- SYCHAR, and this means *liar, or drunkard*.
- SAMARIA is a watch mountain or watch tower.

Bible Differences

People don't flock to church as much as they used to; but they still read from their revised bibles which are called FLAGONS OF WINE.

There is a difference between the Scripture from the 1611 version of the King James Bible and that of other bibles. There are no two bibles the same they have all altered the word of God in some way or another. Even the New King James has made changes but most are so far off that it is pathetic.

I am just going to show you an example of a couple of the differences from the King James Bible and the one that is the most popular bible used in the churches today. As you can see from the chart shown below there are a lot of words being omitted.

Compiling the Scriptures

Deciphering the Scriptures is work! We must dig. There are a lot of secrets that reveal an entirely different story from that which is taught. The Scriptures were composed of symbols and marks that make up roots from which these words come from. The pictures that are symbolized here pertain to verbs:

We could claim that biblical differences come from how these symbols are interpreted but this is not the case. Revised bibles have only changed and omitted many of the words from the 1611 version of the King James Bible while eliminating the *thee's* and *thou's*.

As I have already told you all the nouns are from the roots of etymology. The Hebrew alphabet is different from the English alphabet but the scholars who composed the Scriptures for us knew what they were doing even though it is all Greek to me. (*Pardon my pun.*) All names are the meaning of an attribute; and there are no people in the Scriptures.

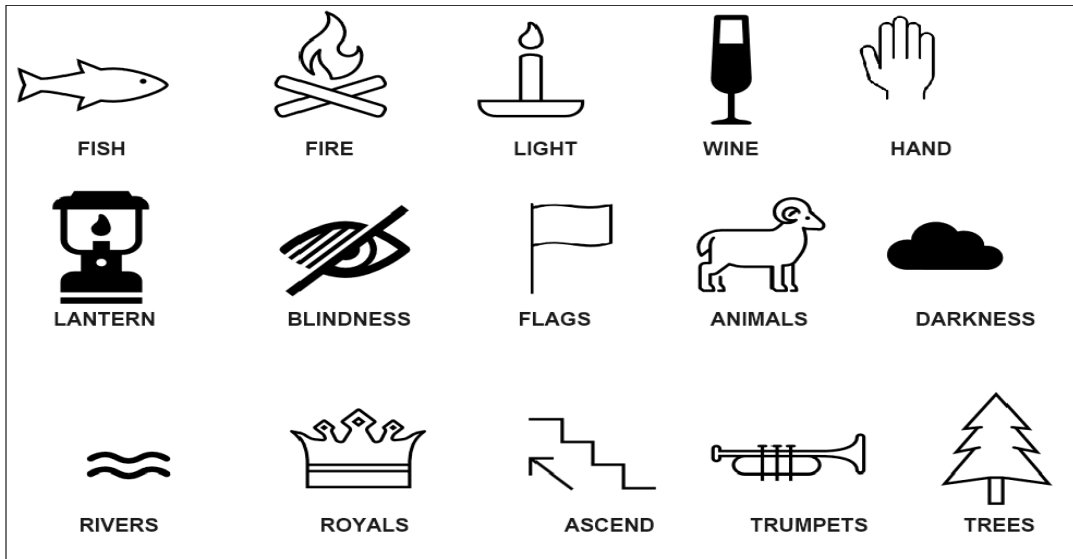
The root of words with a yod are of God.

- ... names that end on a yod (In , the letter ' (*yod*) creates a possessive form when it's postfixed to a word. Take the word מלך (*melek*) for instance. It means king.

- names with a maqqep (Biblical names very often consist of two elements but these are usually

blended together into a seamless unit. Verbs are distinguished with symbols such as these in the diagram.

The Scriptures were deciphered and completed from ancient times. All words come from these ancient roots. We cannot be sure of their accuracy but we can be close. The Scriptures are full of idioms and there are a few that I like to add to them such as they appear to be composed with by guess and by golly; this is an idiom that that means without careful planning; relying on guesswork and luck.



I AM Who I AM

The Scriptures are for everyone especially the Old Testament. These are the words that give us the strength and protection of the exalted father which is YHWH or I AM.

When the Scriptures say that I am the God of Abraham the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob what does it mean?

MATTHEW 22:32 I am the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead but of the living.

33 And when the multitude heard *this* they were astonished at his doctrine.

- ABRAHAM offers us the strength and protection of the exalted father.
- ISSAC means God saves
- JACOB means to follow or be behind.

Jacob is a character of the sinful man whose spirit was once in heaven but has fallen behind. He has twelve sons. These sons represent a trait caused by the way we think of things.

Jacob's sons are fathered by different mothers. A mother is on the negative side from the father. It is important to always keep in mind that these characteristics are not of what we think are real people; but are the aspects that pertain to us put into a parable.

- LEAH is either a mistress or a ruler.
- BILHAH means trouble and calamity.
- ZILPAH means a Drop.
- RACHEL means purity.

These Scriptures below recap on the sons that each of the above characters have brought forth. All my life I have thought just the opposite of these sons because of misinterpretation of my teachings.

**GENESIS 35:23 The sons of Leah; Reuben Jacob's firstborn and Simeon and Levi and Judah and Issachar and Zebulun:
24 The sons of Rachel; Joseph and Benjamin:
25 And the sons of Bilhah Rachel's handmaid; Dan and Naphtali:
26 And the sons of Zilpah Leah's handmaid; Gad and Asher: these *are* the sons of Jacob which were born to him in Padan-aram.**

Let's look at that last word in verse 26. Padan-aram means. From Abarim's Dictionary of Hebrew meanings it is the Ultimate Upgrade. This is from the New Aramaic Standard which defines (1) the verb פדה (pada) to upgrade the operating standard and (2) the verb רום (rum) to be high.

Numerology

Numbers have meanings; everyone knows that one and one equals two, but biblical numerology has caused a great curiosity among readers. Many people believe that numerology reveals much more about secrets; but they will not tell us about the future because the future is already told in the Scriptures.

ECCLESIASTES 1: 9 The thing that hath been it is that which shall be: and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.

10 Is there any thing whereof it may be said see this is new? It hath been already of old time which was before us.

The Scriptures are full of numbers that gives us more information about the Scriptures. When numbers are attached to something tangible such as: time, dimensions, people, animals, or something else, these things refer to with covert meanings. This is meant to throw off the people whom the kingdom of heaven is not intended.

When Jesus spoke to the multitudes he spoke in parables because the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven is not meant for those who think of us as weaklings. What is it they call people who are different? Is it pansies?

MATTHEW 13:10 And the disciples came and said unto him Why speakest thou unto them in parables?

11 He answered and said unto them Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven but to them it is not given.

12 For whosoever hath to him shall be given and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not from him shall be taken away even that he hath.

13 Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not neither do they understand.

The Scale

All words are numbered. This is a phenomenal thing. There are 26 letters in the English alphabet. Words are determined by associating

each letter of a word to a corresponding number. We can find the value of a word by working the Scale: A = 1 B = 2 C = 3 and so forth.

Let's take the word of GOD for instance: G =7, O = 15, D = 4. When we add these numbers together, they will equal 26. Here are a few more words that equal the number 26. Their meanings along with their definitions are: Apace, quickly; Bear, tolerate; bare, reveal, eat , curiosity; God, I AM; and heal. When you come to think about them, they are all in common with understanding the Scriptures.

All words, no matter how long they can be broken down to apply to one the twelve holy numbers. and then reduce them to one of the holy numbers: Number 26 is reduced by adding 2+6 together and this equals 8. This is a number that applies to all people.

Matching the letters to the numbers can be fun and entertaining; we will be dwelling on both the scale and the chart, but I advise you to COPY THEM DOWN AND KEEP THEM HANDY because you will be needing them as we progress through these Little Book.

Being a child of ISRAEL means that our heads have been turned in the wrong direction and must be turned back to where they belong. JACOB means to follow behind; he is the father of the children of Israel. The number of each of these words listed above add to a ten. If we reduce them to the number one, they will revert to the beginning. but each of these words mean something other than what it implies. SATAN likes to mock God he is a mirror image, and his misdemeanor means that he is the adversary and the one who resists.

SATAN who is the adversary and the one who resists likes to mock God; so we will find some words that equal in value to both. However, if we add the Scripture number to the Chapter number it will tell us which one of these characters the Scripture is about.

- 1 Light and the Beginning
- 2 Universal thoughts
- 3 Earthly thoughts
- 4 Spiritual thoughts of understanding the Scriptures
- 5 The living , a nation , or religion
- 6 Biological man which God created on the 6th day
Gentiles
- 7 God's number of completeness belonging to God
- 8 Unity or oneness
- 9 Levels in heaven, the Gifts of the Holy Ghost
- 10 Lucifer, the devil, and the fallen
- 11 The second coming of Christ, and reborn within you
- 12 God's people Israel

We can usually identify what a verse is referring to by adding the chapter and verse numbers together; this tells us more about the Scripture. When adding numbers they must all be separated from each other. This means that randomly asking the number 22 becomes $2+2 = 4$. by separating each number individually. You may have to knock your head against a wall a few times before what I am trying to explain starts to sink in. All numbers above the twelve holy numbers which are shown above must be broken down until they equal one of the twelve holy numbers. Numbers that are spelled out within a Scripture reveal a hidden mystery.

The Sons of Adam

The generation events the story of Adam is the best place to start explaining etymology, numerology, and what appears to be trite. A lot of the Scriptures consist of numbers that are written out; these numbers are always attached to something but mean other than what you see.

As told earlier there are no people or places written about in the Scriptures; these are all characteristics of aspects and attributes that apply to us described by words in etymology. Likewise, there is no time such as ages days nights years hours etcetera even though it appears so. Everything will be explained to you as we go along because this Little Book is your training guide.

To go back to the beginning, there were the sons of Adam: The first born is named CAIN, this mean Disruptive, and Countenance. When he was born, Adam said, "I have gotten a man from the LORD."

**GENESIS 4:5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wrath, and his countenance fell.
6 And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wrath? and why is thy countenance fallen?
7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.**

Adam's second son is called ABEL, and this means Vanity and Breath.

GENESIS 4:8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

This is an event of how disruptiveness and countenance harms our vanity and breath. When our brother's blood cries to us from the ground, it means that that this has become the lifestyle in which we live in.

GENESIS 4:10 And he said, What hast thou done? The voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground.

Not all words are hidden; all the things that we need to know about saving ourselves is spelled out plainly for us to see. The Ten Commandments, which once graced our public places have been removed, but may now be replaced for a remembrance of how we should live by the laws of God. There are other words in the Scriptures that are right before our eyes that get overlooked.

A clergyman, when talking about Cain and Abel, told of how Cain killed his brother and he was put into Nod, “wherever that is! “

GENESIS 4:14 Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, that every one that findeth me shall slay me.

In etymology, NOD means Wanderer. This meaning is clearly stated in the Scripture, but most people can't see it. Cain's son is ENOCH; this means that he is Inaugurated and Trained.

Adam then produces another son. This time he has SETH, which means Anointed; they are the children who have come down from heaven to live among the citizens who were already here.

Genesis 5:3 And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth: [1+3=4] *This means understanding the Scriptures.*

4 And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters: [8+0+0=8] *for all,*

5 And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died. [9+3+0=12] *The children of Israel come to earth.*

6 And Seth lived an hundred and five years, and begat Enos: [1+5=6] *We enter the Earth not knowing of God.*

7 And Seth lived after he begat Enos eight hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters: [8+0+7=16, cut 1+6=7] *We belong to God.*

8 And all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years: and he died. [9+1+2= 10] *We all became sinners.*

Seth begets ENOS, which means weak but a social man, and then comes LAMECH, which means a Strong Man, For Humiliation. The

children of Israel have live with this humiliation all our lives but have learned how to be strong with it so it doesn't get down. However, there are many who have hit rock bottom and need to bounce back.

Here are the meanings of these traits again:

- CAIN Disruptive and Countenance
- ENOCH Inaugurated, Trained
- SETH means the Anointed.
- LAMECH means A Strong Man, For Humiliation

Noah

Noah is the son of Lamech. The meaning of the word for SON is a result of thought, or a trait. Scripture tells us that Lamech lived to be 777-year-old. SEVEN is a number that belongs to God, and His total of completeness. When we add the 777 together, they will equal 21. Reduced again to a holy number it comes to THREE and refers to our time here on the earth. Listed here are a few more words that equal the number THREE and applies the Scriptures in the Bible. This applies to God's time on Earth.

NOAH is a word that means peace and tranquility and a time for rest. When man has had enough of this life and is wanting to return to heaven there are certain procedures he must take.

Since trying to teach these numbers within the Scriptures is so confusing, I find it better to just list each Scripture from Genesis 5 in such manner:

GENESES 5:28 And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years and begat a son: [1+8+2= 10] *Lamech live his life as a sinner.*

29 And he called his name Noah saying This same shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands because of the ground which the Lord hath cursed.

30 And Lamech lived after he begat Noah five hundred ninety and five years and begat sons and daughters: [5+9+5= 19; 1+9= 10] *And Lamech lived as a sinner even after he had Noah because he had sons and daughters.*

31 And all the days of Lamech were seven hundred seventy and seven years: and he died. $[7+7+7=21]$ cut down to $[2+1=3]$ *This is the length of time he spent frolicking on the earth and points to the wrath of the LORD and our time on the Earth.*

32 And Noah was five hundred years old: and Noah begat Shem Ham and Japheth. $[5+0+0=5]$ *says that this is the period when man adopted a heathen religion.*

- ENOS means man who is weak but social.
- LAMECH is a for a strong man and for humiliation strong and robust
- NOAH means peace and tranquility and a time of rest.
- SHEM is the wonderful councilor.
- HAM means hot anger or burnt.
- JAPHETH refers to all the non-believers of the truth of God.

Measuring the Ark

God found grace with Noah and said to make an Ark of gopher wood. Gophers is a word that might mean go-getters that keep digging. The meaning of WOOD is another word that means clandestine to covert meanings; and the Scriptures are slanted with PITCH.

The ark is not a ship or a boat that transported the people who were saved from one life to another. It is instead the Scriptures that are in this Little Book. Let's look at the dimensions in which they are constructed: The Scriptures are pieces about things and thoughts. These pieces are facets called the CUBITS.

God told Noah to place a door at the lowest level and add two more levels above it. The DOOR is where we enter the learning of Scriptures; there are three levels of learning. These levels afford for advancement as we progress in our learning of the true nature of the Word of God. A WINDOW allows us to see through space and to detect the meanings of etymology and converted words.

In measuring the LENGTH of the ark, it shall be three hundred cubits $(3+0+0=3)$ which are the things belonging to the earth; the BREADTH is fifty cubits $(5+0=5)$ and refers to the bread which is the nourishment

that we need to live by; this is aimed at all the people. The HEIGHT is thirty cubits ($3+0=3$) which is also directed to earthly thoughts but when we add this all together. ($3+5+3= 11$) When we add all three dimensions together, we arrive at the holy number of ELEVEN; and this tell us that the second coming of the Christ to be born within you.

GENESIS 6:14 Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

15 And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits the breadth of it fifty cubits and the height of it thirty cubits.

16 A window shalt thou make to the ark and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; with lower second and third stories shalt thou make it.

17 And behold I even I do bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy all flesh wherein is the breath of life from under heaven; and every thing that is in the earth shall die.

A FLOOD of water means an overflow of words. The ARK is a chest or a container of the undercover Scriptures that people can't see when they are physically blind. In this next set of Scriptures, the LORD says to all those who want peace and tranquility which is Noah for all thy house to come into the ark. A HOUSE means all those who have the same views and are looking at this Little Book. Man is a BEAST; the Scriptures are not talking about an animal because there are not animals in the Scriptures only animal traits. We are all sinners; though some of us have or are converting to a new life by repenting from the type of sinful life we were living.

By repenting we are made clean and are not entering God's number of completeness this is signified by the number seven in the second verse which also the rest of the sinners by two which points to heaven. When adding these two numbers seven and two together we arrive at a NINE which is the first step to receiving the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

GENESIS 7 - AND the LORD said unto Noah Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation.

2 Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by two the male and his female.

3 Of fowls also of the air by sevens the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.

4 For yet seven days and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

5 And Noah did according unto all that the LORD commanded him.

6 And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

I assume that the fowls of the air are the thoughts of the past that come and go; they will always be here. The rain is of the water that are upon the earth. FORTY means undetermined so forty DAYS means a time for understanding and the NIGHTS for time when we don't understand. Government is high is called the mountains because of its height; and the churches and synagogues are the hills.

GENESIS 7:17 And the flood was forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased and bare up the ark and it was lift up above the earth.

18 And the waters prevailed and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.

19 And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills that were under the whole heaven were covered.

20 Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered.

The number FIFTEEN [1+5=6] in the last Scripture, verse 20, indicated that the non-believers in God's laws are overcome by the waters even though they don't understand what the ark is.
