

CHAPTER SIX

THE VALUE OF NUMBERS

Biblical numerology has caused a great curiosity among readers. What do they mean?

As far as my ability goes, they don't mean as much as most people think they do. There is no prophecy told in them other than is whatever is already in the Scriptures. However, the numbers let us know what the Scriptures are about. While we have been believing that many of the characters are about the good, we may find that they represent just the opposite.

The numbers that are spelled out in the Scriptures, are meant to throw the people of religion off the beaten path. I have told you the meaning of many Scriptures in previous chapters, but not how I arrived at these meanings.

Everything in the Scripture has a value of Ten or less. I am providing you with a chart of Twelve, but actually eleven = 2, and Twelve = 3. All numbers are added together, separated by digit. Zeros have no value so are not counted. I will try to explain this method in various ways to lessen the confusion.

Here is a chart to follow while trying to figure out the numerology of the Scriptures. You should make a copy of this chart and keep it in your Bible. There are twelve numbers to give you an idea of what the Scriptures are about. I will be referring back to this chart as we go along..

The Twelve Holy Numbers

There are twelve holy numbers to remember. The number 'ONE' means *the beginning*. In the 1611 version of the King James Bible, every verse of the Scripture is numbered in a chapter *except* for the first verse.

Since the number *ONE* is omitted as a diget, it will appear in the Scriptures *an hundred*; this is the same as 100; zeros have no value.

Let's see what the numerology means in Genesis 17:17. This talks about Abraham being an hundred, and Sarah is ninety years old. These are the spelled out numbers that appear in the same verse. When these numbers are added as such $100+90=190$. By adding $1+9$ together we arrive at ten. Ten is ia number that belongs to Satan. If we look at the number of the chapter plus the number of the verse, we must add them thus: $1+7+1+7=16$, or $17+17=34$. Either way we are going to arrive at the number seven. [$1+6=7$] or [$1+7+1+7=16$ reduced to seven by adding $1+6$ together.] Seven is a number that belongs to God. To interpret the meaning of Genesis 17:17 we are told that altho Abraham and Sarah came down from heaven, their heads were turned toward the ways of the earth and now belong to Satan.

We are all born into a world of sin. The children of Israel are not of this world but by coming into it, we have all adapted the ways of the earth. This is why the Scriptures are written in two different ways: one for the people of the earth, and the other for those who came down from heaven and need to find their way home.

We have all been asses. We have thought ourselves as being good

I cannot vouch the accuracy of this chart with the twelve Holy Numbers, but I think it is close.

The Generations of Adam

The definition of ADAM means the *anointed man*. Before there was Adam, man existed:

GENESIS 1:27 So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

In the beginning, we each created our own characteristics; and in the spirit world, this is our image. In this world, we can be as homely as they come but have a beautiful character, or be as handsome as they come and be the devil; therefore, we cannot judge a person by their looks. [1+2+7= 10]

Man's personality is formed around his characterization which come from the traits of animals. All things of the earth are of Satan. Each time we are reborn, we maintain the same character; and when we die, or leave this earth, we will know each other only by our personality.

GENESIS 2:21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

While we are in this earth, we are in A DEEP SLEEP. We might think we are awake, but we are not. The LORD God took one of our ribs and closed up the flesh instead. The RIB was our support, and the FLESH was our

desires. [2+2+1=5] The number five is about the world of religion in which are born into.

GENESIS 2:22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.

And while we are in this deep sleep, we have no protection because woman means the woe of man and is of all the pain and misery that comes with the *human body*. [2+2+2=6] This is still the sixth day, for God has not yet finished his work and rested.

GENESIS 2:23 And Adam said, *This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.*

When the spirit of man became a part of the woman, it took on *the same expression of feelings and desires* that she has. This is the bone of my bones, and the flesh of my flesh. [2+2+3= 7] Seven is a number belonging to the Lord.

ISAIAH 45:7 - I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.

GENESIS 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

The joining of the body and soul together is called a marriage, a this is what is meant by “Til death, do us part,”

GENESIS 2:25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

NAKEDNESS means without protection.

The first conception to come from this marriage was for the birth of CAIN; this is a word that means *a smith, spear, or a political leader, it also means disruptive, or countenance.*

GENESIS 4:7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee *shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.*

8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

Cain's brother was called Abel, which means vanity, or breath.

GENESIS 4: 15 And the LORD said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And the LORD set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him.

What about this mark? I have been debating on a connection between the mark of Cain, and the mark of the beast. Cain slew his brother, ABEL, which means *vanity, breath.*

REVELATION 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

As a child of God, your lamps should be full and your head anointed to knowing the truth of the Scriptures. As the next Scripture says: Do not

retaliate. Forty-nine percent of the populace are sore losers that manufacture as many crimes against the elected regime as they can in order to regain control. This retaliation makes matters even worse.

MATTHEW 5:43 Ye have heard that it hath been said,
Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy.
44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;
45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

GENESIS 4:15 And the LORD said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And the LORD set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him.

We are living in the land of Nod, and we are their guests. This does not mean that we must act like them, but treat them with respect.

REVELATION 13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six

In the Book of Genesis, Chapter 5, we are given an account of the generations of Adam. To the *unlearned* reader, it appears that people used to live for hundreds of years, but the Scriptures are all in code; they are not about people or places, these names are all words taken from the roots

of characteristics. Generations are phases that man goes through all down through the ages.

This next Scripture is about the existence of man, and when he was anointed; Let's look at the numbers:

GENESIS 5:3 And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a *son* in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:

Man existed for 130 eras before Seth was born. $1+3+0=4$. Look at the chart; this means understanding what the Scriptures mean.,

By now, you should have a better understanding of the numerology of the Scriptures. You needn't spend time on figuring out the generations. The only thing you should know is that the years mean eras, the Character are not people but aspects, and what the totals numbers is a verse means.

From the time of Adam to Noah, all these aspects are listed here for your references: The numerology of generations are important and some of the other Scripture, but not in what appears to be geneology.

- ADAM means *man*.
- SETH means *anointed*.
- SONS are the *thoughts belonging to God*.
- DAUGHTERS are *thoughts against God* and are in defiance.
- ENOS means being *weak. but social*, man, and individual.
- CAINAN is that of the *Acquirer*, or *Networker*.
- MAHALEEL means *praising God*.
- JARED means being *educated*,
- ENOCH means being *inaugurated and trained*.
- METHUSELAH pertains to *a man of God*.
- LAMECH means being *a strong man, to strike down*, wild ones.

- NOAH means *peace and tranquility, and a time of rest.*

Measuring the Ark of Noah

We are living in the days of Noah and it is time to rest. In the story of Noah, God finds favor with him and told him to make an ark of gopher wood. The world believes that the Ark is a large ship that carries all the animals to safety. Let these people believe what they will. Since we are not of the people of the earth, and we have repented and are finding our way home; here is the real story:

GENESIS 6:11 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

14 Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

- ARK – Scroll or Bible
- GOPHER - Diggers for the truth
- WOOD - Words with hidden meanings
- PITCH - Slanted
- ROOMS – Scriptures

The ark is not a boat, as people have imagined, but it should help us to stay afloat. and there is not even any mention of it being one in the King James Bible. Now, here are the dimensions. The cubits are facets

GENESIS 6:15 And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.

These are the measurements of the ark's size. CUBITS are *facets*, which means features. When adding the measurements of the ark together, we will learn that the size means that these are the features of heaven. Since the "0"s have no value, they are not counted.

Therefore, when you add the three figures from Genesis 6:15 together and omit the "0"s, it will be like this: $3+5+3=11$ which means the second coming of Christ. Eleven is a double digit, and if broken down into a single digit it will equal "2" which means that the ark is referring to heaven.

- Length – 300 Cubits
- Breadth – 50 Cubits
- Height – 30 Cubits

Even the Chapter number added to the verse $6+1+5=12$, which refers to God's people. By breaking this figure down to a single digit is equals "2" which means that this book is for God's people while on the earth.

The window of the ark is to let in the light. When you are able to see through the window, you will be able to see the other side of the Scriptures.

GENESIS 6:16 A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; with lower, second, and third stories shalt thou make it.

This is an interesting verse that tells us about the three levels of understanding. The Chapter plus verse are $6+1+6 = 13$; and $1+3=4$ which means understanding the Scriptures.

The door of the ark is the most important because this means of Jesus.

JOHN 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

The Rains

There is a pouring down of rain on the internet. This is the waters that the wicked will drown in because it is too deep for them to understand. Scripture tells us that during the time of Noah it rained for seven days upon the earth. This means that it is 'the day of the LORD'

ISAIAH 2:12 For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low:

Rain is a pouring down on the earth as I speak. The weather is raising havoc and people are bringing brought down low.

JOHN 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, *then* are ye my disciples indeed;
32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Christians have a somewhat animosity against Jews although many of them are Jews without knowing it. Jesus is a JEW; the word means, *thanksgiving and praise*.

NOAH is the man that shall feel *peace and tranquility* for those who have dug deep and learned the truth.

The forty days and forty nights refer to the FORTY DAYS as *understanding the Scriptures* (4) and the FORTY NIGHTS means for *both the good and the bad*. $4+4=8$ Together, they mean unity and oneness.

GENESIS 7:4 For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

5 And Noah did according unto all that the LORD commanded him.

6 And Noah *was* six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth

This time of peace and tranquility(Noah) expired when he was 600 years old; Six equals *the people of the earth and nonbelievers*.

Measuring the Ark of the Covenant

God also tells Moses how to build the ark of the covenant. The ark is constructed of SHITTIM WOOD which makes a story more colorful and still has *a hidden meaning*.

EXODUS 24:10 And they shall make an ark *of* shittim wood: two cubits and a half *shall be* the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof.

- Length – 2 and half a cubit
- Breadth – 1 and half a cubit
- Height – 1 and half a cubit

Since a ‘half’ represents a facet. but cubit with either an ‘a’ or ‘an’ represent the number *One*; this can be very disturbing in trying to figure out. However, there is a much easier way to know what it is referring to. All you need to do is add the Chapter number to the verse number, $2+4+1+0=5$. Look at the framed chart of the twelve holy numbers and

you have your answer. We are looking at the heathenism of the Christian and other churches.

The same principle applies to all the Scriptures that tells of the dimensions of the ark of the covenant.

EXODUS 24:17 And thou shalt make a mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof.

There is nothing more precious in our lives than to be forgiven for our trespasses. We are all sinners and without mercy we would be in shambles.

The pure gold of the mercy seat is also represented with a number five. Mercy means forgiveness and compassion for all sinners.

The table of shittim wood are the Scriptures themselves. By looking at the following Scripture. And combing the Chapter and verse numbers, you will see that it covertly adds to the number *eleven* and the second coming of Jesus Christ.

EXODUS 24:23 Thou shalt also make a table of shittim wood: two cubits shall be the length thereof, and a cubit the breadth thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof.

Measuring the Curtains

We all know what curtains are for: they are for blinds. Notice the word “moreover” is in capital letters. This means, *in addition to what has been said* about the ark of the covenant.

EXODUS 26 - MOREOVER thou shalt make the tabernacle with ten curtains of fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: with cherubims of cunning work shalt thou make them.

2 The length of one curtain shall be eight and twenty cubits, and the breadth of one curtain four cubits: and every one of the curtains shall have one measure.

The first verse, which equals eight, means unity or oneness and is for everyone, and it talks about applying the tabernacle with ten. The number ‘ten’ always applies to antics of Satan. The mention of blue, purple and scarlet runs abundantly throughout the Scriptures. These are the colors of the curtains that hide the truth.

- BLUE – means depression of the spirits, dejection or melancholy
- PURPLE – marked by profanity, a passage conspicuous for brilliance
- SCARLET - a feeling of hostility and shame

Processing Multiple Numbers

There is a passage in the 1 Chronicles 18 about David, and how he struck the Philistines, and took Gath, Moab and controlled them. He then struck Hadarezer, king of Zobah, unto Hamath, as he went to establish his dominion by the river Euphrates. DAVID is a word that means *Beloved*.

- PHILISTINES means *Guided by materialism*.
- GATH means *winepress*.
- MOAB means *the land, or the people of the territory*.
- HADAREZER refers to *thunder, and to help or support*.
- HAMATH is *fortification, to protect or surround*.
- EUPHRATES is to *gush or break forth the good part, the fruitful one*

The passage continues, saying that David took the following with him. Remember that the number “ONE” does not appear in the Scriptures.

1 CHRONICLES 18:4 And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven thousand horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: David also houghed all the chariot *horses*, but reserved of them an hundred chariots.

Here are the numbers in this Scripture:

- DAVID means beloved
- A THOUSAND means a *very* large amount
- CHARIOTS are the means of transporting people
- SEVEN means belonging to God
- HORSEMEN are the riders of a horse.
- TWENTY, or two means that this is about heaven.
- FOOTMEN are those headed in a direction.
- AN HUNDRED means a large amount.

The processing of triple numbers and much more information on numerology is found in the following book, *Teacher of Scripture, The Three R's*, Chapter Two.

The Corn

We who are of the children of Israel are the ignorant blokes whose heads were turned toward the ways of the earth. *This earth* is called EGYPT in the Scriptures. We are living in Satan's world; there is no denying it. There may be things happening that we do not like, but we must live with them; and the more we retaliate against them, the worse it will get. Therefore, it is best to go with the flow.

There is a lot of corn in Egypt. The next story is about Jacob and his sons. JACOB is the man who came down from heaven; he is *a follower and is behind*. His SONS are his *thoughts, his aspects and characteristics*.

GENESIS 42 - NOW when Jacob saw that there was corn in Egypt, Jacob said unto his sons, Why do ye look one upon another?

2 And he said, Behold, I have heard that there is corn in Egypt: get you down thither, and buy for us from thence; that we may live, and not die.

3 And Joseph's ten brethren went down to buy corn in Egypt.

CORN relates to be *corny*; *trite or emotional*; this is what the world is like. There is not much truth in it, but we are so used to hearing the lies, we believe in them.

These next two Scriptures are about the same thing, but using different words which will be identified below. I find them very interesting!

LUKE 11:42 But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

MATTHEW 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier *matters* of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

- PHARISEES means a great civilization.
- TITHE OF MINT is a ten percent fabrication.
- ANISE is a seed used for expelling intestinal gas.
- CUMMIN is a plant used to disguise the aroma.
- RUE means sorrow.
- HERBS are plants of annual, biennial, or perennial doctrine that dies down at the end of the growing season.

In repeating the Scripture on previous page All the hype we hear is corn.

GENESIS 42 - NOW when Jacob saw that there was corn in Egypt, Jacob said unto his sons, Why do ye look one upon another?

2 And he said, Behold, I have heard that there is corn in Egypt: get you down thither, and buy for us from thence; that we may live, and not die.

3 And Joseph's ten brethren went down to buy corn in Egypt.

If you are among those who disagree with the doctrine of the churches, and even find many things wrong with what the governments are telling us, then maybe you will find it all a bit corny. We all pay for the stuff that we are being fed, whether it be religion or the government; and much of it is corn.

GENESIS 3 -NOW the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

2 And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:

3 But of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

The children who came down from heaven thought that the corn in Egypt would save them from death, but just like Adam and Eve, they were wrong.

GENESIS 42:2 And he said, Behold, I have heard that there is corn in Egypt: get you down thither, and buy for us from thence; that we may live, and not die.

There is only one way to live and not die. God made a covenant with the children of Israel in the Old Testament. However, they are mentioned only two times in the New Testament.

Everything that Jesus taught is from the Scripture that is in the Old Testament'; he added nothing new.

MATTHEW 27 - WHEN the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:

2 And when they had bound him, they led him away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor.

3 Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

4 Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that.

5 And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

6 And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood.

7 And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

8 Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day.

- **CHIEF PRIESTS** are the pastors who took council against Jesus to put him to death.
- **PONTIUS** refers to the people with a religious mind.
- **PILATE** means to be equipped with spears and ready to conquer.
- **JUDAS** is from Judea meaning praise and thanksgiving.
- **THIRTY** points to all the things of the earth.
- **INNOCENT BLOOD** is the Spirit that gives us eternal life.
- **POTTER'S FIELD** is the earth where we have been all been planted.

Judas and Jesus are both named from the the root of Judea, giving praise and thanks. Jeremiah the name of the weeping profit

**MATTHEW 27:9 Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;
10 And gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord appointed me.**

Here is the first mention of the children of Israel in the New Testament found that things of the earth loses their value. Jesus is the principle that gives us life, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;

To Judas, The Word of God was valued at thirty pieces of silver, THIRTY pertains to *all the things of the earth*. These were the things that the children valued.

**MATTHEW 27:11 And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest. And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;
10 And gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord appointed me.
11 And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest.
12 And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing.
13 Then said Pilate unto him, Hearest thou not how many things they witness against thee?
14 And he answered him to never a word; insomuch that the governor marvelled greatly.**

In the Scriptures, it is said that Jesus stood before the governor who asked if he were the King of the Jews; but Jesus did not answer. Let's keep in mind that Jesus is *not* a person, he is the Spirit that man needs in order to save himself. This Spirit was crucified because the Jews spit on him.

**MARK 14:64 Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.
65 And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophecy: and the servants did strike him with the palms of their hands.**

We cannot put a price on Jesus, our salvation is priceless. We must try to let friends and family that God is not outside of us, because He is inside of each of us. The majorities are God

PSALM 82:6 I have said, Ye *are* gods; and all of you *are* children of the most High.

Summarized

To summarize this book, you don't need to read the Bible, nor do you need to understand it. The Bible may soon be outlawed as being too controversial because of too many versions.

This little book has avoided many of the issues that are facing the world today: Politics, Religion, Magic, AI, Robots, Etcetera, Etcetera. Its main purpose was to make you aware that there are two sides to the Scriptures, and what they are.

Whether you believe in any of it is of your own prerogative. All we need to know is that we are each a part of God, and the will of the majority is God's choice, whether it be good or bad.

God made a covenant with Abraham, which means the multitudes. This covenant was that if we complied to the rules of God and avoided all sin, we would have a happy and enjoyable life. This covenant was repeated in The New Testament. The world still wants to believe that Jesus is a man rather than being the thoughts of overcoming the world with humbleness and being happier without the luxuries.

Take this book in your stride. Hopefully, through the knowledge gained here, you will have a happier life after this one.
